EMAAN is an initiative of the Muslim Association of Canada (MAC), a religious, educational, charitable and non-profit organization. EMAAN was established in 2002 to recognize the achievement of Muslim students in Edmonton and to promote education - a fundamental principle of Islam. The program is in its 15th year having evolved into a comprehensive program that celebrates the excellence of Muslim youth in academics, athletics and community involvement at the high school level. Over the years, EMAAN programs have been established in 6 large cities in Canada including Edmonton, Calgary, Ottawa, London, Waterloo and Windsor. In order to celebrate the diverse, vibrant, and enthusiastic Muslim youth in our community, this is our second year for EMAAN in Hamilton, and we expanding our horizon to include Halton region as well. EMAAN honors each participating student from Hamilton-Halton who achieve academic excellence, and will be awarding two scholarships of \$500.00 each for special students who excel above and beyond their peers in different areas of interest including arts, science, religion and athletics.
